

Coexistence Manager for GroupWise

Deliver ZeroIMPACT GroupWise coexistence with Office 365 and Exchange

Historically, organizations have relied on GroupWise Gateway, Microsoft's 2003 Connector or SMTP routing for GroupWise and Exchange coexistence, whether during a migration or to integrate disparate environments. These coexistence methods are difficult to install, lack the level of functionality typically required and involve considerable risk. For instance, when using these native solutions, free/busy lookups are inaccessible between platforms, recurring calendar appointments may not translate properly, GroupWise and Exchange users don't share a common directory, business productivity is disrupted and, ultimately, revenue suffers.

Coexistence Manager for GroupWise maintains business productivity by ensuring interoperability between GroupWise, Office 365 and Exchange, including Exchange Server 2016.

Coexistence Manager also mitigates the risk of disrupted messaging and communication between end users by:

- Providing free/busy lookups
- Ensuring accurate calendar scheduling, including custom recurring meetings
- Synchronizing directories between platforms

Free/busy connector — Provides free/busy lookups between GroupWise, Office 365 and Exchange. Users can view availability and schedule meetings with other users, no matter where their mailboxes reside.

Directory connector — Synchronizes directories between GroupWise and Exchange. Users on both platforms can view a common list of users, groups and resources.
